Learned counsel for the petitioners has handed over two cheques of an amount of ₹5 lakh each dated 26.8.2019 and 16.09.2019, respectively, towards the discharge of the amount due to the bank.

Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that since the petitioners have already filed SA-137-2019 before the DRT-II, Chandigarh, which is pending for 02.09.2019, therefore, they may be relegated to pursue the said application before the DRT and in the meantime order passed by this Court dated 30.5.2019 may be continued.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has not raised any objection in this regard, therefore, the present petition is hereby disposed of by relegating the petitioners to continue with their remedy of securitization application bearing SA-137-2019 before the DRT-II, Chandigarh. DRT-II, Chandigarh is directed to decide SA-137-2019 as early as possible preferably within a period of three months. Till then order dated 30.5.2019 passed by this Court shall continue.
