Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0001 dated 03.01.2018 registered under Section 306 of IPC at Police Station Ghanie Ke Bangar, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Vide order dated 23.02.2018 passed by this Court, the present petition was ordered to be listed along with CRM-M-6344-2018 and interim order was passed in the same terms.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 23.02.2018 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Santokh Singh, states that in the aforesaid FIR, police has prepared cancellation report and

submitted the same to the concerned court on 18.04.2018. However, the court has ordered reinvestigation in the case. As a result thereof, fresh cancellation report was prepared on 05.01.2019 and the same is in the process of being filed before the court.

In view of the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and the police has prepared cancellation report, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 23.02.2018 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

As regard the apprehension of the counsel for the complainant that there is an immediate threat to the complainant, the complainant is at liberty to approach the authority concerned for the relief.
