Petitioner seeks a mandamus for directing respondents No.2 and 3 to protect his life and liberty and to take action against respondent No.7 who is alleged to be raiding the house of the petitioner without even registration of any FIR or search warrants and that too, at the instance of private respondents No.4 to 6.

In the light of the prayer raised in the petition and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the same in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach respondent No.3 i.e. the Commissioner of Police, District Ludhiana as regards his grievance and threat perception.

In the eventuality of any such application being preferred, respondent No.3 would be obligated to look into the matter and to thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and as warranted in accordance with law.
