The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 01.02.2019 passed by this Court in CWP No. 14269 of 2016. The operational part of the order is quoted below:

“ In view of the above, the present writ petition is allowed. The petitioner is held entitled for interest @ 9% per annum from 01.10.2012 onwards till the same is paid to the petitioner.”

A reply by way of an affidavit of Sh. Gurlovleen Singh Sidhu, Managing Director, PEPSU Road Transport Corporation, Patiala filed in Court today is taken on record, a copy is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner. It is stated that the following payment has been paid:-

Learned counsel for the petitioner is not in a position to dispute the said fact due to lack of instructions. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law against the order passed.

In view of the above, no cause of action survives in the present contempt petition.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondents stand discharged.

However, in case there is any discrepancy with regard to payments stated to be made, the petitioner would be at liberty to revive the petition.
