At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that representation Annexure P-8 dated 11.10.2018 has been submitted by the petitioner to respondent No.2 for redress of his grievances which are the subject matter of the instant petition and that the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed off at this stage by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation Annexure P-8 dated 11.10.2018 in a time bound manner.
