The present petition was filed with following substantive prayers:-

“It is therefore, most respectfully prayed that the present petition may kindly be allowed and necessary direction may kindly be issued to official respondents to carry out fair and impartial investigation and submit status report in criminal case bearing FIR No.278 dated 14.12.2017 registered under Sections 382/336 IPC at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

It is further prayed that direction may be issued to the respondent No.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, so that they may not become a victim of continuous oppression and violence inflicted upon them by the accused persons and deliberates inaction and sadness of

State Police Mechanism as they are being pressurized at the behest of the accused persons by the local police to compromise the matter as otherwise threats are being given that they will be implicated in some false criminal cases.

It is further prayed that direction may be issued to the respondent No.1 and 2 to handover the investigation of case FIR No. 278 dated 14.12.2017 registered under Sections 382/336 IPC at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran to some independent Investigating Agency and it may further be directed that the investigation be supervised by some Senior IPS rank officer as the local police is deliberately giving shielding to the accused persons due to ulterior motives, in the interest of justice and equity.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Karanjeet Singh, has submitted that the police after investigation has found no merit in the case registered and, therefore, cancellation report has already been submitted in the Court.

In view thereof, petitioner is relegated to the remedy before the competent Court.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
