Petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail in FIR
No.82 dated 11.04.2019 under Sections 381/34 IPC registered at P.S. City
Kapurthala.

It is submitted that the matter has been amicably settled
between the parties. Co-accused Neelam has been afforded the concession
of anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 08.05.2019 in CRM-M-
19419-2019 (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI
Gurmail Singh affirms and verifies that the matter has indeed been settled
between the parties and the Court has afforded the concession of
anticipatory bail to Neelam.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as above, it is

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considered just and appropriate to allow this petition. Consequently, in the event of his arrest, petitioner be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer. Petitioner shall comply with the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
