KRISHNA MURARI, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral):

After the matter was heard at some length, learned counsel for the appellant, on instructions from the appellant who is present in the Court, made a request that he may be granted some reasonable time to vacate the shop in question and the appeal be dismissed as withdrawn.

After considering the entire facts and circumstances, we permit the appeal to be withdrawn with a liberty that the appellant shall continue to retain possession of the shop in question for a period of 6 weeks from today with the condition that the entire outstanding arrears/charges would be paid to the respondents for the use and occupation and also the amount for the period of 6 weeks being permitted under this order shall be deposited in advance within two weeks from today. The appellant shall file an undertaking in the form of affidavit in this Court within two weeks that he shall hand-over the vacant possession of the shop in question on expiry of a period of 6 weeks, free from all encumbrances, to the respondents.
