Main Case

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 04.07.2018 passed in CWP No. 2874 of 2007.

Learned State counsel has filed compliance report by way of affidavit of Mr. Dilbagh Singh, Joint Director O/o the Director Elementary Education, Haryana, Panchkula, same is taken on record. Copy handed over to the counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that most of the petitioners have retired and apart from re-fixation of pay, the pensionary benefits would also be required to be refixed.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. Madan Kumar, Deputy Superintendent, submits that the needful would be done within four months from today, subject to the outcome of curative petition if so filed.

In view of statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition is disposed of.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

However, it is made clear that in case the afore-said statement is not adhered to, petitioners would be at liberty to file application for revival of the present petition.
