1. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner was caused injuries including grievous injury by Gurbal Singh, Raju, Manjot and Rajinder and that he was also medico legally examined at Civil Hospital, Doda and pursuant to the information given to the police although the police recorded DDR but no FIR had been lodged despite the fact that the facts disclosed commission of cognizable offence. It has been submitted that the petitioner had also made a representation dated 1.5.2019 (Annexure P-4) to the police but even the said representation has remained undecided.
2. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and without

expressing anything on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib to look into the matter and to dispose of representation (Annexure P-4) expeditiously in accordance with law.

3. A copy of this order along with copy of representation (Annexure P-4) be sent to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously preferably within a period of “three months” from today.
