The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.28 dated 02.05.2019 registered under Sections 420, 120-B IPC at Police Station City Balachaur, District SBS Nagar (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are not only false and vague but the same were found to be false during investigation as he had nothing to do with the agreement to sell nor was he a shareholder in the property in question.

A perusal of the FIR reveals that the petitioner has not only been specifically named in the FIR but an amount of ₹ 12 lakhs was also transferred vide demand draft No.080748/194802 dated 01.07.2016 in the name of the petitioner after he had lured the complainant to invest the same in their company with an assurance that the money would double in just 20 months.

Keeping in view the above, in my opinion, the petitioner does

not deserve the concession of anticipatory bail as all the accused including the petitioner in connivance with each other duped the complainant of huge amount.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
