By this petition, filed under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks the concession of regular bail.

On 15.7.2019, learned counsel for the petitioner having submitted that the petitioner having been arrested on 12.4.2019 (erroneously shown as 12.4.2015 in that order), the challan has still not been presented, with learned State counsel directed to take instructions with regard to the forensic science laboratories/chemical analysis laboratories in the State of Punjab.

On the next date of hearing, i.e.16.8.2019, it had been stated by learned State counsel that the report from the Forensic Science Laboratory had just been received, with it however to be submitted to the competent Court. The petitioner was ordered to be admitted to 'interim bail'.

Thereafter, the turn of the case not having come up till 4.00 pm on two dates, it was adjourned to 25.11.2019, on which date counsel for the

petitioner was not present, with the interim order however continued in his favour. The matter was therefore directed to be listed today, to be shown in the urgent motion list.

Today, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ajaib Singh, submits that the quantity of contraband stated to have been recovered from the petitioner (as per the case of the investigating agency), was 275 grams of Tramadol Hydrochloride, with the commercial quantity 'starting from above 250 grams'.

He further submits that are 6 other criminal cases registered against the petitioner.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, for or against the petitioner, I see no reason to entertain this petition any longer, which is consequently dismissed, with the interim order vacated.
