Status report by way of affidavit of Gurmeet Singh, PPS, Deputy Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar on behalf of respondent-State has been filed. Same is taken on record. Copy has been supplied.

The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.85 dated 12.04.2019, registered under Sections 323, 354, 452, 506, 427, 34 IPC, at Police Station Rama Mandi, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is ready to pay an amount of Rs.50,000/- as compensation to the complainant.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation; nothing is to be recovered from him and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case,

I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the present case.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 31.05.2019 is made absolute, subject to payment of Rs.50,000/- as compensation to complainant Smt. Sunita by way of bank draft in her name and further subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. However, the petitioner is directed to deposit the said amount before the Secretary, District Legal Services Authority, Jalandhar, who will summon the victim Smt. Sunita and hand over the said amount to her against proper receipt and identification. The said amount shall be without any prejudice to the rights of the parties

Petition stands allowed accordingly.
