The petitioners have preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.92 dated 19.06.2018, registered under Section 304-B IPC, at Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar Rural.

Both the petitioners were found innocent during the investigation, therefore, the final report was filed against Markas Masih son of Sadiq Masih. As such, petitioners are not required for custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in the present case.

Therefore, the instant petition stands allowed. It is ordered that the petitioners be released on interim bail, subject to their furnishing bonds

to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, they shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. failing which they shall loose the benefit of anticipatory bail allowed to them.
