This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to decide the legal notice dated 29.4.2019 (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 - Financial Commissioner, Department of Rural Development and Panchayats, Punjab to consider and decide the legal notice dated 29.4.2019 (Annexure P-2) expeditiously.

Heard.

A complete set of paper book has been handed over to Mrs. Anju Sharma Kaushik, DAG, Punjab in the Court today.

In view of the above, without advertting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2

- Financial Commissioner, Department of Rural Development and Panchayats, Punjab to consider and decide the legal notice dated 29.4.2019 (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law within six weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
