1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to take appropriate action on his representation dated 23.7.2018 (Anneuxre P-4).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he had booked a ticket for her sister who is residing at London for her visit to India in the month of July, 2018 through M/s Brilliance Holidays, but he realized that he had infact been duped and a forged ticket was sent to him. It has been submitted that a representation (Annexure P-4) in this regard was made to the police on 23.7.2018 but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

3. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T. Chandigarh to look into the matter and to dispose of representation (Annexure P-4) expeditiously in accordance with law and in case, it is found that the same discloses cognizable offence, then necessary steps be taken thereupon preferable within a period of “three months” from today.
4. A copy of this order along with copy of representation (Annexure P-4) be sent to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, U.T. Chandigarh so as to enable him to do the needful.
