In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstance, the present petition is hereby disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to file a comprehensive representation, or representation in which a proposal shall be made to respondents No.1 and 2 as to how the payment of the outstanding amount shall be made. In case such a representation is made within the period of one week from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, the respondents No.1 and 2 shall decide the said

representation in accordance with law within a period of one month thereafter by passing a speaking order.
