Petitioner has filed this petition with following substantive
prayer:-

“It is, therefore, respectfully prayed that the present petition may kindly be allowed and directions may kindly be issued to respondents No.1 to 3 especially respondent No.2 to initiate appropriate enquiry and proceedings against the respondent No.5 on the basis of report of respondent No.4 dated 28.1.2019 (Annexure P-3), in the interest of justice.”

Today, Director General of Police, Punjab has filed affidavit in
the Court, para 3 whereof reads as under:-

“3. That in compliance with the abovesaid order dated 13.9.2019 passed by this Hon'ble Court, the matter was examined in the office of the deponent, whereupon the Inspector General of Police, EOW, Bureau of Investigation,

Punjab was directed to examine the matter and submit report to the deponent. The IGP/EOW, BoI, Punjab summoned the relevant records from Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar and Vigilance Bureau, Punjab, SAS Nagar.”

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition be disposed of by directing AIG/Vigilance Bureau, EOW, to conclude the enquiry within a limited time frame.

Learned counsel for the State has no objection to the prayer made.

In view thereof, the present petition is disposed of by directing AIG/Vigilance Bureau, EOW to conclude the enquiry within a period of three months.
