Learned State counsel has filed reply on behalf of Mr. Virender Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Bhiwani wherein, as has been submitted by learned State counsel a case by way of FIR No.359 dated 29.10.2018 under Sections 384, 509 IPC read with Section 3 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 has been got registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Bhiwani on the complaint of one Bala Devi wife of Braham Parkash, and on the allegations of the petitioner a cross case bearing FIR No.679 dated 10.09.2018 under Sections 218, 219, 34, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC has been got registered, stating further that the latter FIR has since been cancelled and proceedings under Section 182 IPC have been initiated against the complainant present petitioner and that in the first

FIR, investigations have been completed and report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. stands submitted before the concerned Court.

In the light of the same, nothing survives in this petition and the same stands disposed off as such.

However, in the light of apprehension shown by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner might be arrested again on some other complaint by the disgruntled complainant, directions are issued to the official respondents to ensure that in case an FIR is registered against the petitioner, seven days' clear notice be given to him to enable him to have his legal recourse.
