At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that representation Annexure P-4 dated 08.03.2019 has been submitted by the petitioner to the respondent for redress of his grievances which are the subject matter of the instant petition and that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the writ petition is disposed of at this stage by directing the respondent to consider and decide the representation Annexure P-4 dated 08.03.2019 in a time bound manner.
