The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.0029 dated 20.03.2019 registered under Sections 307, 324, 323, 34 IPC (Section 325 IPC added subsequently) at Police Station Mehtian, District Hoshiarpur.

It is contended by counsel for the petitioner that the dispute involved in the matter had erupted due to misunderstanding between the parties. Hence, a better sense prevailed upon the parties subsequently. Accordingly, both the sides have settled their disputes amicably and they have filed petitions for quashing of the cases registered against the respective sides on the basis of compromise after settling the dispute amicably. Hence, no dispute survives between the parties anymore.

On the other hand, learned State Counsel, being instructed by ASI Sewa Dass, does not dispute the fact that the petitions have been filed by both the sides for quashing on the basis of compromise of the cases registered against the respective sides.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioner be

released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/ sureties to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Duty Magistrate.
