GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No. 358, dated 4.12.2017, registered at Police Station City, Ferozepur, under Sections 324, 506, 323, 148 and 149 IPC and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 27.2.2018 the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get the statements recorded.

Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ferozepur has been received to the effect that statement of complainant/injured Amandeep Singh, Malkit Singh and Lovepreet Singh and also of petitioners/accused Partap Singh, Gurjant Singh, Manjit Singh @ Mani Sidhu, Amarjeet Singh @ Amardeep Singh, Harpreet Singh and Happy have been recorded to the

effect that they have entered into a compromise with the intervention of respectables. The complainant/injured have specifically stated that they have no objection if the FIR in the present case is quashed. Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ferozepur opined that the compromise arrived between the parties is a valid and genuine compromise, which is voluntarily and out of free will of the parties.

In view of the aforesaid report and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 358, dated 4.12.2017, registered at Police Station City, Ferozepur, under Sections 324, 506, 323, 148 and 149 IPC and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
