Petitioner seeks a Mandamus for issuance of directions to the concerned respondent authority to issue to him an Arms License pertaining to a non-prohibited bore gun for self defence.

The short grievance raised in the petition is that even though an application dated 13.3.2018 complete in all respects had been submitted but till date no final decision thereupon has been taken. It is urged that neither has the Arms License been issued nor an order of rejection has been passed.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. N.K. Parmar learned A.A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents and waives service. A complete copy of the petition already stands furnished to learned State counsel.

Statement of learned State counsel is recorded to the effect that in case an application for issuance of an Arms License submitted by the petitioner is still pending, the same would be processed in accordance with law and under the provisions of the Arms Act and rules framed thereunder and a final decision would be conveyed to the petitioner expeditiously and in any case within a period of three months from today.

In the light of such statement recorded of learned State counsel,
no further directions are required to be passed.

It is, however, clarified that this Court has not examined the
claim of the petitioner for issuance of Arms License on merits.
