On 20.06.2019, the following order was passed:

“In the present case, FIR was registered on 17.09.2017. The petitioner claims that he is regularly attending his office and for more than one year, there were no steps against the petitioner, however, now the Investigating Officer after a period of 01 year and 09 months of the registration of the FIR is trying to falsely implicate the petitioner.

Adjourned to 01.08.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2), Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI

Surender Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation,
co-operated and not required for further custodial interrogation at this stage.

Hence, the order dated 20.06.2019 is made absolute.
