The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 11.1.2019 passed by this Court in CRM-M No. 847 of 2019.

The petition was disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Rupnagar to decide the representation dated 13.10.2018 made by the petitioner.

On notice, reply by way of affidavit of Swapan Sharma, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Rupnagar dated 8.8.2019 has been filed.

As per the reply, an enquiry was conducted and vide report dated 17.7.2019, representation of the petitioner has been consigned.

Copy of the enquiry report has been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner today in Court. He submits that he may be permitted to avail remedies in accordance with law if aggrieved of the

enquiry report.

In view of the above, the contempt petition stands disposed of as infructuous with liberty aforesaid.

Rule issued against the respondent is discharged.
