HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner was ordered to be released on probation for a period of one year with a condition to deposit Rs. 1,40,000/- i.e. double of the cheque amount within a period of 1 month from the date of the order i.e. 28.09.2016. He further states that because of the marriage of his daughter the said amount could not be deposited within stipulated period.

Hence the present petition was filed and vide order dated 06.07.2017 the Coordinate Bench of this Court directed the petitioner to deposit the amount of Rs. 1,40,000/- before the learned trial Court within 7 days.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has drawn the attention of this Court towards the order dated 13.07.2017 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Ellenabad, which shows that the complainant has received demand draft No. 153247 dated 11.07.2017 reserving his right to contest the revision petition on merits before this Court.

Despite service, there is no representation on behalf of the respondent. Still further, as the directions given by the learned trial Court as also by this Court regarding deposit of requisite amount stand duly complied with, there is no requirement for securing the presence of the respondent.

Since, the order dated 06.07.2017 passed by this Court has been complied with as the petitioner has deposited the due amount within a stipulated period, the present petition is allowed. Resultantly the non-bailable warrants issued against the petitioner shall stand withdrawn.
