Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 26.05.2019 (Annexure P-3) for protecting their life and liberty from respondents No.4 to 6 as they are in relationship against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 6.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1 – Sukhdeep Kaur, aged 23 years and petitioner No.2 – Karanjit Singh, aged 20 years are in relationship against the wishes of their family members, arrayed as respondents No.4 to 6. It has further been submitted that the private respondents are threatening to interfere in the life of the petitioners. Hence, they are seeking protection in that regard and have approached this Court by way of filing the instant petition.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of Court, Mr. Dhruv Dayal, Sr. DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

5. In view of the above, the petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2-Sr. Superintendent of Police, Bathinda to look into the representation dated 26.05.2019 (Annexure P-3) and take necessary steps, if

any required, in accordance with law, to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioners is not jeopardized at the hands of the private respondents. However, this direction will have no effect on any civil or criminal action, which could be initiated in the matter in accordance with law.
