Pleadings on record have been perused.

As per pleadings on record, petitioner is serving on the post of Bill Clerk under the Water Supply and Sanitation Department, State of Punjab.

Prayer in the instant petition is for issuance of a mandamus for directing the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of respondents No.5 to 7 and who happen to be senior officials under the Water Supply and Sanitation Department itself.

Pleadings on record are not sufficient for this Court to infer any immediate threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner. Rather averments in the petition would convey an impression that the instant petition is a fallout of a charge sheet having been served upon the petitioner at Annexure P-3 by the Executive Engineer, Sanitation Mandal, Pathankot.

No interference in the matter is warranted.

Petition is dismissed.
