No one appears on behalf of the petitioners. Even on the last two dates, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners.

The prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to the respondents for transfer of investigation of FIR No.160 dated 26.10.2017, registered under Sections 302, 148 & 149 IPC at Police Station City, Batala, to some other independent agency.

Reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division City, Batala, is filed in Court today which is taken on record.

As per the reply, the police, after completing investigation, has submitted a report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. against accused Karan Ratti on 30.01.2018 and supplementary challan against accused Sahil Bhagat was presented on 13.04.2018. It is further stated that a supplementary challan against accused Jatti Dolly, Varun Dolly and Jatin was presented before the Illaqa Magistrate on 23.05.2018 and another supplementary challan against accused Gurmukh Singh, who is a proclaimed offender, was presented on

14.05.2018.

It is further stated that now the case is committed to the Court of Sessions and charges against accused Karan Ratti and Sahil Bhagat have been framed on 13.08.2018 and case was thereafter listed for prosecution evidence.

In view of the same, no further direction is required in this case. This petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
