The present petition has been filed for issuance of direction to the respondent-State to provide protection to the petitioner so as to enable him to raise construction on the first floor of his own house.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner even on the third call in post lunch session.

This Court has already held in another petition i.e. CRM-M-20457-2019 decided on 06.05.2019 that unless the statutory proceedings have already been initiated by a statutory authority or Court under Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'Cr.P.C.'), the petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is not maintainable for issuance of any direction. The remedy is a writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed.
