This revision has been filed against the order dated 19.4.2017 passed by Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana whereby charges framed against respondent No. 2 is set aside.

Counsel for the respondent No.2 states that respondent No.2 has died and this petition has become infructuous. Counsel for respondent No.2 has also placed on record death certificate which is taken on record and marked as Mark 'A'. Since none has come present on behalf of the petitioner, liberty is granted to him to revive if any action survives.

In the circumstances, the petition is abated against respondent No.2 and dismissed as having been infructuous.

Since the main case has been dismissed as infructuous, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands dismissed.
