On 03.06.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that bare simplicitor allegations in the FIR bear out history of earlier disputes between complainant-Gurpreet Singh, a forest guard and the petitioner side and that nothing is to be recovered from him.

Notice of motion for 02.09.2019.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petition shall, however, join the investigation as and when called for to do so and he shall also abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Amrik Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, interim order dated 03.06.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
