Prayer in the petition is to grant regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.40 dated 15.03.2019 registered under Section 379-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Govt. Ranjit Avenue, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 15.03.2019 for theft of ₹1500/-. He submits that investigation is complete and challan has been presented and the petitioner is not involved in any other case.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State has filed custody certificate which shows that petitioner is in custody since 15.03.2019 i.e. for a period of 3 months and 18 days and there is no other case against the

petitioner.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
