ANIL KSHETARPAL, J. (ORAL):

Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.34 dated 26.04.2019 under Sections 21/61/85 of the NDPS Act registered at Police Station Zira.

On 03.06.2019 the following order was passed by this Court:

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has been nominated as an accused pursuant to a disclosure statement made by co-accused.

Notice of motion for 18.7.2019.

At this stage, Mr. H.S. Grewal, Addl. A.G., Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A copy of the petition be furnished to the learned counsel representing the State during the course of the day.

It is not disputed that the petitioner has not been involved in any other case.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of

Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from the investigating officer submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and not required for further custodial interrogation. In the present case, total recovery is from three co-accused and that also does not fall under the commercial category.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the order dated 03.06.2019 is made absolute.
