This is not a dispute which falls within the writ jurisdiction. It is purely a dispute relating to land and construction of Janj ghar or a school and the answer lies in evidence not in affidavit jurisdiction exercised by the High Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India. Petitioners are relegated to the remedies before the Civil Court, a remedy more wholesome than writ proceedings, since conflicted questions of fact can be resolved on evidence.

The petition is dismissed.
