The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of directions for lodging of FIR against the private respondents and his accomplices.

The learned counsel has submitted that although he had made a complaint (Annexure P-2) to the police on 6.9.2018 but no action has been taken thereupon.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting anything on the merits of the case or as regards the veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Superintendent of Police, Rohtak to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation (Annexure P-2), moved by petitioner, expeditiously in accordance with law. In case, it is found that the allegations are well founded and disclose commission of criminal offence, then necessary steps be taken thereupon as warranted under law.

A copy of this order alongwith representation (Annexure P-2) be sent to respondent No.3-Superintendent of Police, Rohtak so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
