Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members from respondents No.4 to 7 and to take appropriate legal action on the representation dated 10.04.2019 (Annexure P-3), which has been filed before respondent No.2.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the private respondents No.4 to 7, against whom he had instituted a civil suit, which is still pending before the Ld. Civil Judge (Sr. Divn.), Gurdaspur. The private respondents No.4 to 7 are threatening him with dire consequences in case he does not withdraw the civil suit and are pressurizing the petitioner to compromise the matter. He further contends that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the petition is disposed off with a direction to the official respondents to consider his representation (Annexure P-3), in accordance with law.

3. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, the petition is disposed off with a direction to the respondent No.2-Sr. Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur, to look into the representation dated 10.04.2019 (Annexure P-3) and

take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

4. The present petition stands disposed off.
