Challenge in this petition is to the order dated 24.07.2017 passed by the trial Court vide which the application filed by the respondent under Section 311 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, for leading additional evidence, was allowed.

During the pendency of the present petition, the parties have arrived at an amicable settlement and the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for recording their respective statements.

The parties have arrived at a settlement/compromise recorded by the Mediator in which the petitioner has paid an amount of Rs.1 lac to the respondent as full and final settlement against the dishonouring of the cheque before the Mediator and the respondent has agreed to withdraw the main complaint pending before the trial Court on the next date of hearing i.e. 28.03.2019.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of having been rendered infructuous.

The parties shall remain bound by the settlement arrived at before the Mediator and the respondent will withdraw the complaint on 28.03.2019.
