The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 06.02.2019 passed by this Court in CWP No. 15922 of 2017. The operative part of the order is reproduced below:

“Learned State counsel on instructions from Shashi, Law Officer, office of DPI (SE) Punjab, submits that the Secretary Education, Punjab, would consider the matter in light of orders dated October 30th, 2018 and September 13, 2018 within six weeks and take necessary steps. In case, any adverse decision is taken, same shall be conveyed to the petitioners forthwith. The information received by the petitioners under the Right to Information Act has been handed over to learned State counsel. He submits that the same shall also be looked into.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is satisfied with the statement made by the State counsel.

Petition is, thus, disposed of.”

A short reply by way of affidavit of Sukhjeet Pal Singh, Director of Public Instructions (SE) Punjab, filed in Court is taken on record. A copy of the same is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in view of the reply filed in Court today, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition.

Disposed of as infructuous.

Rule issued against the respondents is discharged.
