Petitioner seeks a mandamus for directing official respondents No.1 to 3 to take necessary steps to protect his life and liberty by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has been heard and the writ paper book has been perused.

The averments made in the writ petition are utterly vague. No specific incident/occurrence has been cited and on the basis of which this Court may infer any real apprehension of threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner.

In the absence of the necessary pleadings, prayer made in the petition cannot be accepted.

Petition dismissed.
