This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 5 to take legal action against private respondents No.6 to 10 on the complaint/representation (Annexures P-3, P-4 and P-5).

In support of his contentions, reliance has been placed on the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Mahender Chawla and others v. Union of India and others**; 2019(1) RCR (Criminal) 268.

Heard.

The petitioner has already filed a complaint No.938 of 20118 titled as Devi Dayal v. Pardeep Kumar @ Happy and another which is stated to be pending.

No case is made out for issuance of any directions as prayed for. However, the facts in *Mahender Chawla's* case (supra) are distinguishable.
