This criminal revision petition has been filed against the judgments passed by both the Courts below.

Learned trial Court as well as First Appellate Court have found that the prosecution has miserably failed to bring home the guilt of the accused persons. It is undisputed that the alleged forged agreement to sell has not been produced by the prosecution in evidence. The Courts have further found that the prosecution has not led sufficient evidence to prove that the aforesaid agreement to sell was forged.

It is also undisputed that a civil suit for specific performance of the agreement to sell on the basis of the alleged forged agreement to sell, has already been decreed, although, first appeal against the same is pending.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Court does not find any good ground to interfere.

Hence, the revision petition is dismissed.
