Petitioner-Hardeep Singh @ Musa has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.07 dated 26.01.2018, under Sections 427, 457 read with Section 511 IPC, Police Station Sadar Ahmedgarh, District Sangrur.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel appeared and filed reply contesting the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

As per prosecution version, allegedly petitioner along with co-accused attempted to commit theft at ATM of Punjab National Bank. Though damage was caused to the ATM Machine but there was no loss of cash. Petitioner is in custody since 02.04.2019. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes. It is pertinent to mention here that

co-accused Rajesh Kumar @ Bangali has already been released on bail by this Court, vide order dated 11.09.2019. Since trial of the case would take sufficient time to conclude, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner in custody further and, thus, he deserves the concession of bail.

As a sequel to above said discussion, for the foregoing reasons, but without commenting on the merits of the case, instant application for grant of bail moved by petitioner- Hardeep Singh @ Musa is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bond/surety bond(s) to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
