The petitioner seeks bail upon him having been arraigned as an accused after 52 kgs of poppy husk are stated (as per the case of the prosecution) to have been recovered from him.

As per the custody certificate filed in Court today by learned State counsel, the petitioner has put in 04 months and 27 days of actual custody, with no other criminal case seen to be registered against him.

That being so and the quantity of the poppy husk being only marginally above the commercial quantity, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
