The present revision petition is filed against the order dated 19.03.2019, passed by the Civil Judge (Junior Division), Rupnagar (for short, the trial Court), vide which, the suit qua defendant No.1 under Order 9 Rule 2 C.P.C. has been dismissed as the petitioner could not provide the correct address of defendant No.1 in spite of various opportunities.

This Court would have issued notice but for the fact that the petitioner has already impleaded respondent No.1 in the present revision petition alongwith the fresh address.

Accordingly, in the interest of justice, the present revision petition is allowed and the order dated 19.03.2019 passed by the trial Court is set aside to the extent, vide which, the petitioner has not been allowed to serve defendant No.1, subject to costs of ₹5,000/-. The petitioner is now allowed to serve respondent/defendant No.1 on the address as mentioned in

the present revision petition. As the main petition has been disposed of, the miscellaneous application, has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.
