Status report by way of affidavit of Sh. Sukhchain Singh Gill, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, has been filed. Para Nos.3 and 4 of the same reads as under:-

“3. It is further submitted that immediately on receipt of the copy of the directions passed by this Hon'ble Court, the answering deponent called for a detailed report from Additional Deputy Commissioner of Police (Investigation), Ludhiana and it has been reported that the allegations mentioned in the complaint bearing UID No.1134527 dated 27/06/2017 submitted by the petitioner were enquired by the then Assistant Commissioner of Police (Special Branch-Cum-AHT Unit), Ludhiana and it has transpired that the petitioner has already taken back Rs.5,10,000/- alongwith a cheque for a sum of Rs.17,85,000/- and if this cheque has been dishonored, then the petitioner is at liberty to file a complaint u/s 138 of N.I. Act. On the basis of the findings of Assistant Commissioner of Police (Special Branch-Cum-

AHT Unit) and Additional Deputy Commissioner of Police (Investigation), Ludhiana, this complaint was filed by the then Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana.

4. It is further submitted that another complaint bearing UID No.1266302 dated 23/01/2018 submitted by the petitioner is being enquired by Deputy Commissioner of Police (Investigation), Ludhiana, because Inderpal Singh respondent No.4 has already submitted a complaint bearing CR No.1123774 dated 13/06/2017 against the petitioner and his family members, which is also being enquired by Deputy Commissioner of Police (Investigation), Ludhiana. As and when, the enquiry is completed from all the angle, further appropriate legal action will be taken in accordance with law and both the complaints bearing CR No.1123774 dated 13/06/2017 submitted by respondent No.4 Inderpal Singh UID No.1134527 dated 27/06/2017 submitted by the petitioner will be disposed of together.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petition can be disposed of while directing the concerned official to complete the investigation.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from H.C. Harmesh Lal, has submitted that enquiry shall be completed within a period of 8 weeks.

In view thereof, the present petition is disposed of.
