Pursuant to order dated 02.05.2017, passed by this Court, the competent authority has passed an order dated 05.07.2017 (Annexure R-3/10), whereby financial assistance has been directed to be given to the widow of the employee, who died in harness as per Clause 4 (1) (b) of Ex Gratia Policy, 2003.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in view of the grant of ex gratia compensation, the present writ petition is rendered infructuous.

3. Per contra, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he has not been furnished a copy of the order dated 05.07.2017 (Annexure R-3/10). The same has been handed over to him in course of the hearing.

4. The writ petition is dismissed as infructuous in view of

the grant of Ex Gratia Compensation vide order dated 05.07.2017 (Annexure R-3/10).

5. In the event, the Ex Gratia Compensation as per Order dated 05.07.2017, has not been disbursed to the petitioner till date, let the same be done within a period of two months from today failing which the petitioner shall be entitled to compensatory interest @ 15% per annum w.e.f 29.06.2019 till the actual date of payment.

6. Petition stand disposed of.
