The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in the event of her arrest in FIR No.7 dated 19.01.2018 under Sections 498-A, 313 and 120-B registered at Police Station Sarhali, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in pursuance to the order dated 12.03.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

He further states that the petitioner is mother-in-law of respondent No.2-complainant, and so far as the recovery of alleged gold articles is concerned, vide order of even date, this Court has already ordered in connected petition i.e. **CRM-M-14372 of 2019** titled as **Jaspreet Singh Versus State of Punjab and another** that Jaspreet Singh, who is son of the present petitioner, shall deposit an amount of Rs.6,50,000/- before the trial

Court within a period of four weeks from today, in the shape of FDR in some nationalised bank in the name of respondent No.2-complainant.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the fact that the petitioner is mother-in-law of respondent No.2 and has joined the investigation coupled with the fact that vide order of even date passed in **CRM-M-14372 of 2018**, this Court has already directed Jaspreet Singh, who is son of the petitioner, to deposit an amount of Rs.6,50,000/- before the trial Court by way of FDR in some nationalised bank in the name of respondent No.2-complainant, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 12.03.2018 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
