The present contempt petition has been filed pleading that the order dated 12.3.2019 passed by Educational Tribunal (Colleges) Punjab at SAS Nagar, Mohali (for short, 'the Tribunal') has been intentionally disobeyed.

The Tribunal had directed Adesh Institute of Technology, Ludhiana-Chandigarh Highway, village Gharuan, District Mohali to take a decision on the legal notice within a period of two months from receipt of a certified copy of the order.

The copy of order was supplied on 14.3.2019.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner realising that no notice has been given after the expiry of the period, submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present contempt petition at this stage with liberty to serve notice to the respondents.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

There is no doubt that atleast after service of notice the respondents shall appreciate that the direction given by the Tribunal was time bound.
