The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 22.2.2019 passed by this Court in CWP No. 17872 of 2018. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“Learned State counsel at the outset submits that issue shall be considered by the competent authority and a decision shall be taken on the legal notice, Annexure P-8. Copy thereof shall be conveyed to the petitioner within six weeks.

In view of above, no further direction is necessary.

Petition is hereby disposed of.”

Learned counsel for the State has produced order dated 9.8.2019, copy thereof has been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

In the order, it has been stated that the legal notice has been kept pending for adjudication as the matter is sub-judice before this Court in a bunch of Writ Petitions, lead case being CWP No. 13619 of 2015, titled **-Baljinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and others.**

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present contempt petition at this stage with liberty to file a fresh one if cause of action survives after the decision of the aforementioned writ petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
